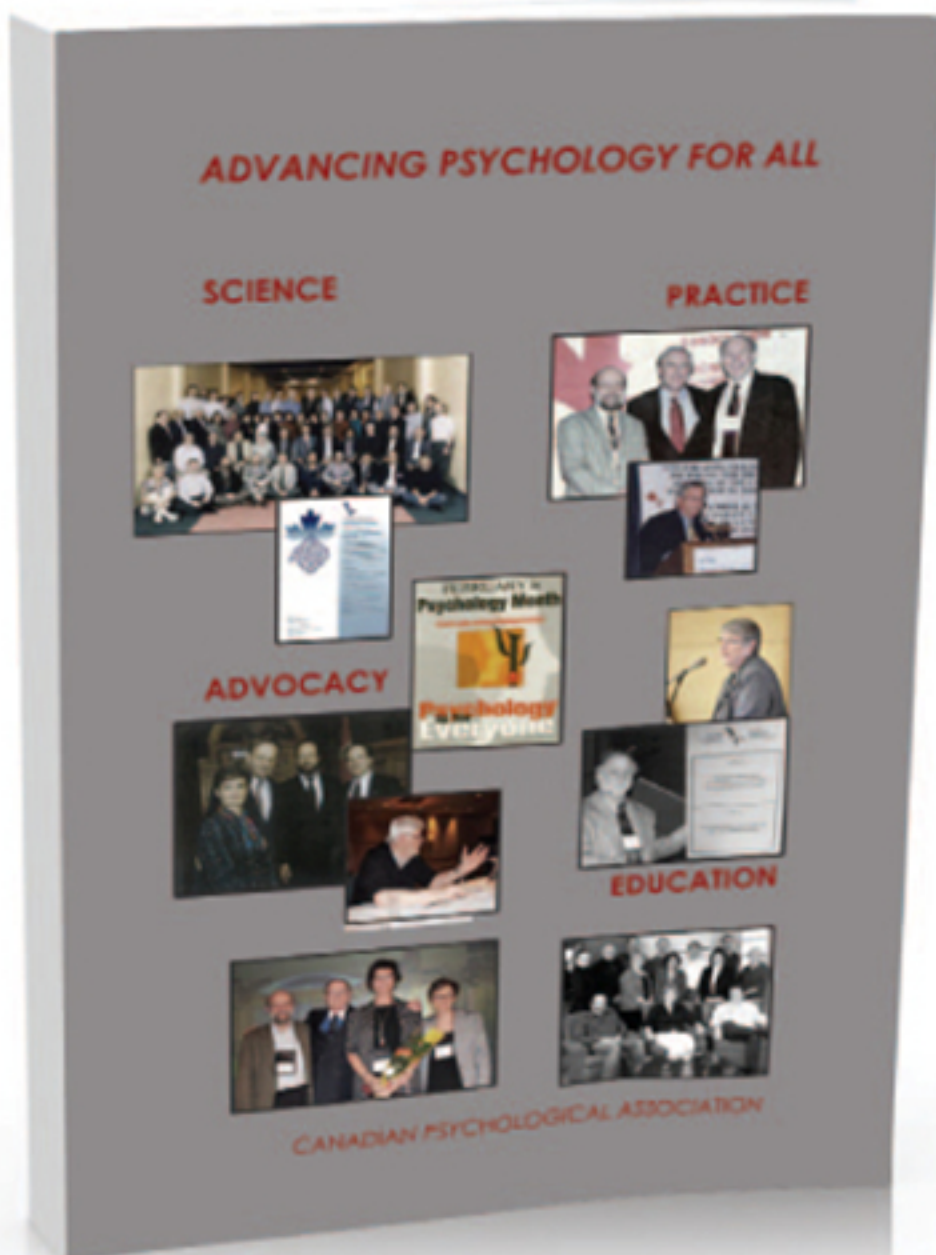
Almost 500 pages and with many photographs from the archives, *A Chronicle* documents milestones in CPA's history, including early attempts in the 1940s to establish pan-Canadian certification, the Opinicon and Couchiching conferences of the 1960s, the tremendous growth of Canadian psychology in the 1960s and 1970s, the Status of Women in Canadian psychology, The Code of Ethics in the 1980s, Accreditation of professional training programmes in the 1980s, the growth of CPA's Sections in recent decades, and enhanced advocacy efforts for science and practice from the 1990s to today. Brief Biographical Notes on over 300 Canadian psychologists are included.
